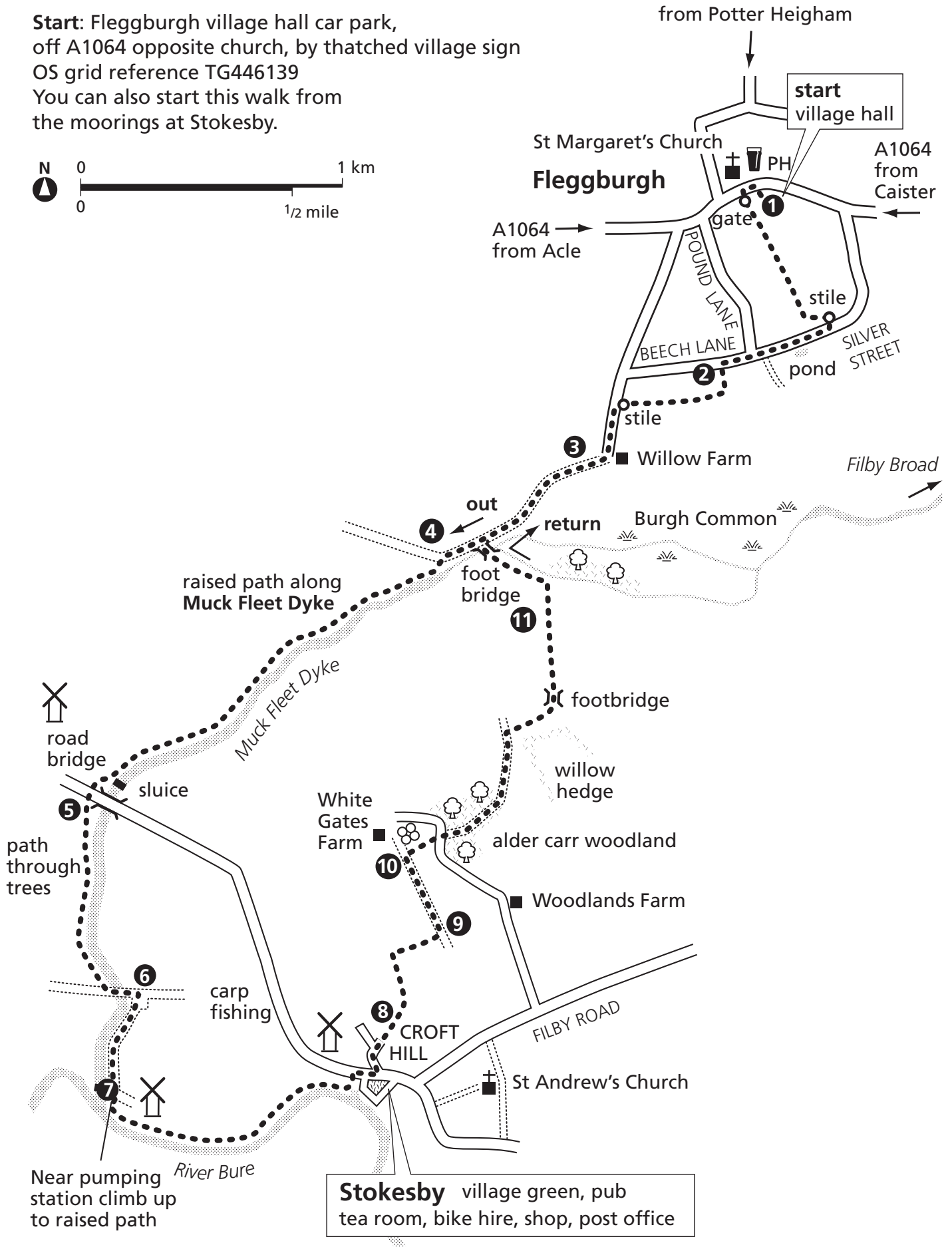


Broads Walks: Fleggburgh (Burgh St Margaret) to Stokesby

7 miles (11 km) 3 – 3½ hours

Start: Fleggburgh village hall car park, off A1064 opposite church, by thatched village sign
OS grid reference TG446139
You can also start this walk from the moorings at Stokesby.



Broads Walks: **Fleggburgh (Burgh St Margaret) to Stokesby**

Route

- 1 Turn left out of the car park, along the road. Take the path to the left opposite the church. The path runs beside the village hall and goes over a field beside a playing field. The side of the footpath is lined with oak trees and a hedge with wild flowers. Follow the path for about 500 m. On approaching some houses, go over the stile on the right and then turn right into Silver Street and Beech Lane. Follow the lanes past the pond for about 300 m, passing Pound Lane, until you reach a public footpath to the left, through a gap in the hawthorn hedges.
- 2 Follow the path through fields for about 500 m. Go over the stile to the road and turn left along it. The road then becomes a track - go straight ahead.
- 3 Continue past Willow Farm, then follow the footpath that forks right. Follow the footpath for about 800 m, passing a wooden footbridge on the left.
- 4 Stay on the raised grassy path with the Muck Fleet Dyke to your left and grazing marsh to your right. Bear left to continue along the grassy path. Walk along this path for just over a mile (1.6 km) until you reach a road bridge.
- 5 Cross the road and continue on the path on the opposite side, with the Muck Fleet still on your left, for about 1 km.
- 6 Cross the concrete area and continue on the concrete track bearing right to the River Bure and a pumping station.
- 7 When you reach the pumping station, climb up to the riverside path and turn left. Follow the path to Stokesby, passing a drainage mill without sails.
- 8 At Stokesby the path leads to a road, where you turn right. Pass the village green. You can take a pleasant detour here to the church, or turn left up Croft Hill just past a bus shelter. Follow the road for about 100 m, then where the road bends left, take the footpath on the right next to a house.
- 9 Follow the path across the field. Turn left along the field edge. Then turn right and left along the track towards White Gates Farm.
- 10 Turn right before the farm, cross the road and continue on the path through woodland. Go over a footbridge and continue until you reach the footbridge across the Muck Fleet which you passed on your way out.
- 11 Cross the bridge, turn right and retrace your steps to the car park.
