BEDFORD MIDLAND

Main line rail connections south to Luton, St.Albans, London, Gatwick Airport and Brighton. Connections north to Wellingborough, Kettering, Leicester, Derby, Nottingham and Sheffield.

Walk straight ahead when leaving the station and cross Ashburnham Road and follow signs to Bus Station and town centre, library, tourist office etc.

ST. JOHNS

Turn right at the top of the steps for Bedford South Wing Hospital and Ampthill Road shops, post office etc. Turn left at the top of the steps and walk down the bridge for the Business Park and the River Great Ouse.

Leave the station by the footpath towards County Hall and turn right into Melbourne Street for KIDS WORLD, children's activity centre (ring 01234 326309 for details).

KEMPSTON HARDWICK

Turn right when leaving the station and walk along Manor Road. The CHIMNEY CORNER Public House is at the junction of Manor Road and the main road from Bedford to Ampthill. Sign-posted footpaths provide pleasant walks towards Stewartby.

STEWARTBY

For details of a walk to Millbrook via Stewartby Lake, see overleaf.

Follow sign-posted footpaths from the station to the MILLENNIUM COUNTRY PARK.

Stewartby village is about 10 minutes walk from the station. Turn left when leaving the station and continue past the entrance to the brickworks.

The village Shop and Post Office is in Stewartby Way, to the right of the brickworks.

MILLBROOK

Follow sign-posted footpaths from the station to the MILLENNIUM COUNTRY PARK.

Station Road leads to the village of Marston Moretaine.

LIDLINGTON

For shops, post office and church, turn left into Church Street.

For The GREEN MAN Public House, turn right from Church Street into High Street. The pub is a short distance past the Village Hall. For details of opening times, facilities etc, contact The Green Man on 01525 402869.

The "Greensand Ridge Walk" is close by and covers about 40 miles from Gamlingay to Leighton Buzzard. Walk along the High Street (up hill) for about 1km where the route crosses the road - left for Ampthill and right for Woburn.

RIDGMONT

For details of bus connections to the village and to Woburn ring the Milton Keynes TravelLine - 08457 382000.

For circular walk via the old tramway, see details overleaf.

The Marston Gate Business Park is a few yards to the north of the station.

ASPLEY GUISE

Turn left when leaving the station. Walk along Salford Road, past the village Church for the shops, post office and walks in Aspley Woods, via West Hill, bearing left into Wood Lane, with the woods straight ahead through the gate.

The ANCHOR Public House is in Salford Road. For opening times and facilities etc, please contact The Anchor on 01908 582177.

WOBURN SANDS

The STATION HOTEL has a range of railway memorabilia in the main bar. For details of opening times and facilities etc, Please contact the Station Hotel on 01908 582495.

For GARDEN CENTRES, turn left when leaving the station. FROST'S Garden Centre is on the left and WYEVALE Garden Centre is about 0.5 miles from the station, on the right.

Turn right outside the station and proceed along Station Road to the High Street for shops, restaurants, post office etc.

There is a regular bus service from Station Road to the centre of Milton Keynes. Ring the TravelLine on 08457 382000 to confirm details.

BOW BRICKHILL

For circular walk via village Church, see details overleaf.

From platform 1, turn right into Station Road for THE WHEATSHEAF Public House. For details of opening times and facilities etc, please contact The Wheatsheaf on 01908 370947.

Bow Brickhill is the closest station to the Open University.

There is a small, free car park about 2 minutes walk from the railway station, to the north of the railway crossing.

FENNY STRATFORD

For circular walk via the Grand Union Canal and Caldecotte Lake, see details overleaf.

For shops, leave the station via the Watling Street exit.

BLETCHLEY

Main line rail connections north to Milton Keynes, Northampton, Rugby and Birmingham and south for stations to Watford and London Euston

For Bus Station, Leisure Centre and Shopping Centre, turn left outside the station and left again at the bottom of the steps.

For BLETCHLEY PARK, home of the world's first programmable electronic computer, cross Sherwood Drive opposite the station exit and a footpath leads to the park. Please check opening dates and times - ring 01908 640404
