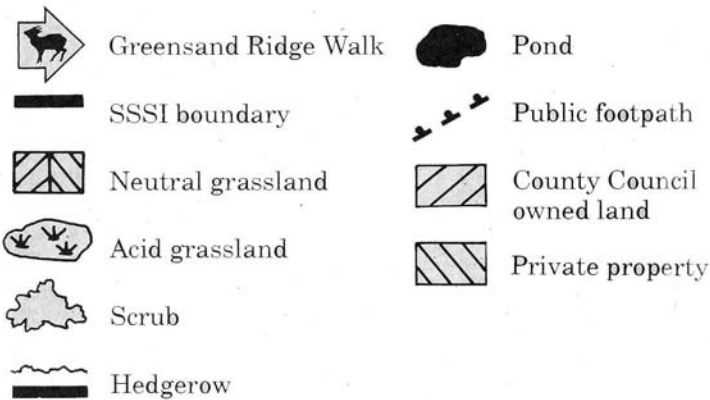


Introduction

Maulden Church Meadow is an ancient pasture designated by the Nature Conservancy Council as a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) because of its importance to nature conservation. Bedfordshire County Council owns and manages eight and a half acres of the meadow as a Local Nature Reserve. Two acres, at the southernmost end of the meadow, are privately owned. Less than sixty acres of flower rich meadow remain in the county.
