The Sewell Greenway provides a delightful route for walkers, cyclists and horse riders to escape into nature. Built on the old railway line between Stanbridgeford and Frenchs Avenue in Dunstable, the land is a County Wildlife Site boasting diverse flora and chalk grassland habitats.

The Greenway and the route through Dunstable and Houghton Regis form part of National Route 6 of the National Cycle Network, which provides walking and cycling routes between Milton Keynes, Luton and London.

A safe and attractive new route for walkers and cyclists between Stanbridge. Dunstable and Houghton Regis

Used informally for years, recent work has provided two surfaces along most of the Greenway's length: hard for bikes, wheelchairs and pushchairs, and soft for horses, meaning that everyone in the community can visit. The Greenway will also be linked with Houghton Regis and Luton via the developing urban cycle network and via public transport.

Sustrans - the sustainable transport charity - works on practical projects to encourage people to walk, cycle and use public transport in order to reduce motor traffic and its adverse effects, 5,000 miles of our flagship project, the National Cycle Network, were officially opened in June 2000, we will increase this to 10,000 miles by 2005.

The National Cycle Network is a comprehensive network of safe and attractive routes to cycle throughout the UK. 10,000 miles are due for completion by 2005, one third of which will be on traffic-free paths the rest will follow quiet. lanes or traffic-calmed roads. It is delivered through the policies and programmes of over 450 local authorities and other partners, and is co-ordinated by the charity Sustrans.
