Walk Instructions:

1. The water works building is situated on the bend on Hall Road. With the building on your right proceed east along the lane a short distance. As the lane begins to straighten out, look for a green mesh fence on your left side. At the mesh fence, take the clearly defined footpath which slopes up and away into a steady incline, follow it until you meet with the road.
2. At the road turn right. Continue a short way along Hobland Road; soon you will come to a farm and post box.
3. On your right, opposite the farm entrance is the start of a field edge path; a finger sign points the way. Follow this field edge path as it dog legs first right then left. Here the footpath begins a steady decline.
4. As the field path ends, climb over the stile beside the metal bar gate, and turn right. Follow this lane with views of the reservoir back to the start of the walk.
